Agenda Items

1. Grant welcomed everyone and thanked them for their help in making Seussical a success.
2. Seussical – outstanding photographs were distributed. Iain will compile a slideshow of Terry's photographs so that anyone still wishing to order photographs can see them.
The closed dress rehearsal worked well.
Catering worked well, with the Sunday having a particularly good feel to it.
FTH is booked for next year, although at the moment there is still a slight problem with the hire of the lesser hall on the Saturday afternoon.
£760.00 was collected from programme advertising, on-screen advertising and sponsorship, with a further £150.00 having been paid directly into the bank account for sponsorship.
Show week collections were between £700.00 - £800.00.
£100.00 – raised £378.00.
Invoice received from Weinbergers for a balance of £3500.00. £4027.00 minus the deposit paid previously.
D.V.D of Seussical is almost finished.
Backstage – In future we will have security to ensure there are no difficulties during or at the end of a show. A review of the backstage guidelines should take place before the new session.
Attendance – Policy to be reviewed. Agnes will look at numbers of rehearsals missed last session.
Post Production meeting to be arranged before next committee meeting to clear outstanding issues.
3. Production Team – Iain will issue Gavin, Jonny and Sheila with contracts for the coming show. The production team should advise the committee of their associate.
4. Treasurers Report – unavailable
Grant will arrange to meet with Steven to hand over money and to obtain cheques for invoices which need paying.
5. Secretaries Report – Membership forms should be sent out by the weekend, with a return date of 28th March.
Member survey to be sent out.
6. New member auditions on Saturday 29th and Sunday 30th March. Agnes has the groupings ready. The audition process is now set to best enable children to show their talents.
The panel will consist of Jonny, Gavin, Lynsey, Sheila and Grant.
7. Workshops will possibly take place for gymnastics and stage fighting. Grant will contact Gavin to see what he is thinking about workshops.
8. Fundraising – on the back of the very successful bag packing and Carol Singing in Asda at Stenhousemuir it was decided that this is what should be concentrated on this coming year. We have already been offered a date, 27th December for bag packing at Asda, Stenhousemuir. Asda in Falkirk would also like us to do Carol Singing as would Boots.
Fiona will continue to be in contact with the necessary people as well as contacting Tesco at Reddingmuirhead to enquire about bag packing.
A Matalan Fashion Show is to be held in November.
A family quiz night is to be organised for end of September or beginning of October. Vivien to find out about hiring the Masonic Hall in Denny. Agnes will contact the butcher about pies for the event.
